**Tax Deadline Changed**

The deadlines to FILE and PAY 2019 federal income taxes are postponed to July 15, 2020. IRS is offering [coronavirus relief to taxpayers](#).

Use this secure service to pay your taxes for **Form 1040 series, estimated taxes or other associated forms** directly from your checking or savings account at no cost to you.

You can easily keep track of your payment by signing up for email notifications about your tax payment, each time you use IRS Direct Pay.

- Email notification will contain the confirmation number you receive at the end of a payment transaction.
- The IRS continues to remind taxpayers to watch out for [email schemes](#). You will only receive an email from IRS Direct Pay if you've requested the service.

If you have already made a payment through Direct Pay, you can use your confirmation number to access the Look Up a Payment feature. You can also modify or cancel a scheduled payment until two business days before the payment date.

You can also view your payment history by accessing your online account with the IRS.

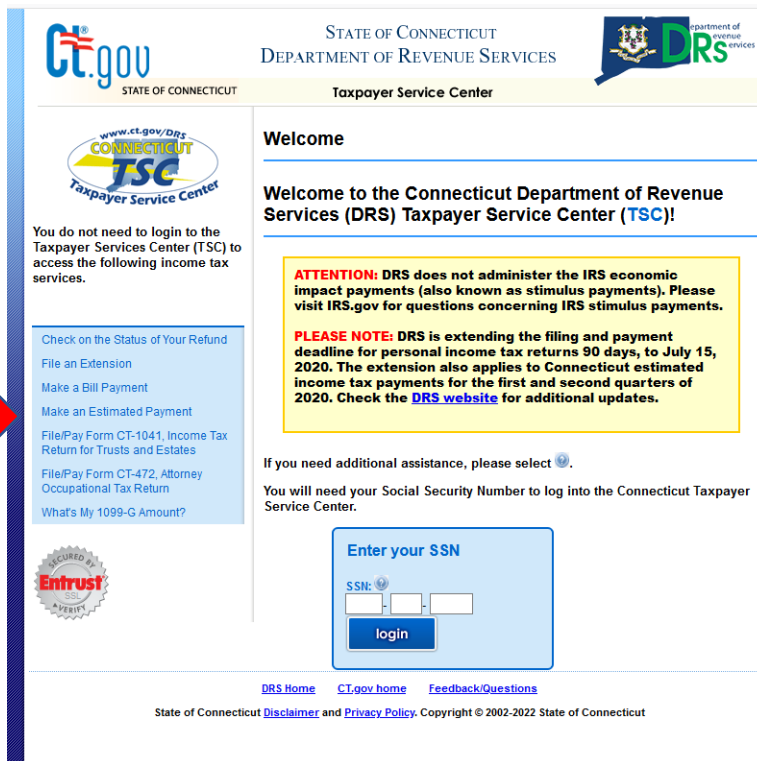
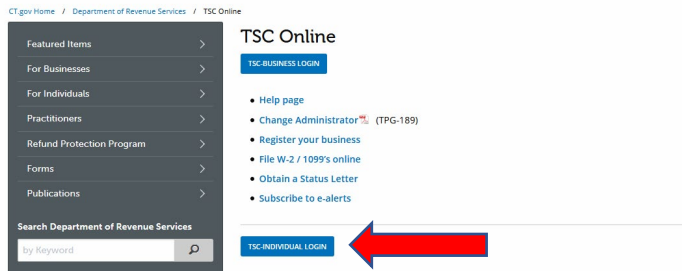

For tax payments, choose “Tax Return or notice,” then “1040, 1040A, 1040EZ” and the appropriate year. For estimates, choose “estimated tax” in the first dropdown menu. Please note: once you choose “estimates,” the Tax Period will automatically default to the current year.

The next screen will ask you to verify your identity; please use the previous year to do so (for example, if you have filed your 2019 return, choose 2018 to verify your identity) and click “continue,” you will be brought to a screen where you must enter your checking account and routing information and verify the amount of the estimated payment you wish to make. You then “sign” for the payment by typing in your name. You will get a confirmation of payment, which you should print for your records. And that’s it!

To pay CT taxes due or estimates, go to <https://portal.ct.gov/drs/tsc/tsc-online> and choose Individual Login.



To make a CT estimated tax payment or pay taxes due, or to check the status of your refund, navigate to the choices on the left side of the page to pick. In this example, we've chosen to make an estimated payment to CT. The screens will then prompt you to enter information such as your Social Security Number, information that verifies your identity and your banking information.

Once you complete the process, a confirmation of your payment page will appear, with an option to print for your records. And you're done!
